
Walk 9 Transport: Exceat to Eastbourne

Parking at Exceat is available in three places, one of which is free.

The car park beside the A259 opposite the <u>Seven Sisters Country</u>


<u>Park</u> visitors centre is pay-and-display, as is the more secluded woodland car park behind the visitors centre (Postcode **BN25 4AD**).

The charges are £3.50 all day. The machines do not take notes or cards so bring change.



A little to the west, on the other side of the Cuckmere River over Exceat Bridge, is the free riverside car park adjacent to the <u>Golden Galleon restaurant</u>. Drinks and light meals can also be had at the Farmhouse tea rooms behind the visitors centre, though we found it prone to closing early in bad weather if there was no custom. Shelter can be had inside the visitors centre if waiting for transport

and there are toilets and regular buses towards Eastbourne and to Seaford and Brighton.



On street parking is possible in Duke's Drive Eastbourne where a kiosk (postcode **BN20 7XN**) marks the end of the SDW.
